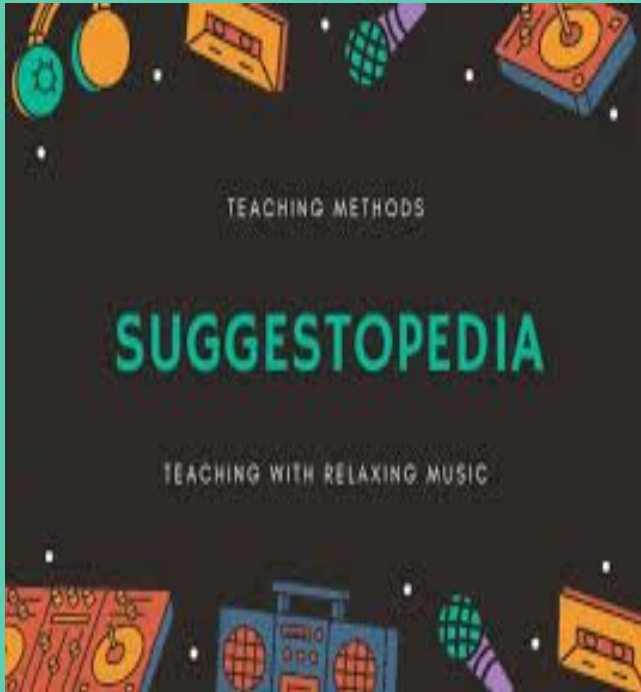

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SUGGESTOPEDIA

Historical Background:

- Suggestopedia is a language teaching method developed by the Bulgarian psychologist, **Georgi Lozanov**.
- Suggestopedia is an innovative method that promises great effective language learning results.
- Lozanov claimed that by using his method one can teach languages approximately **three to five** times as quickly as conventional methods.
- The name combines the terms "**suggestion**" and "**pedagogy**", the main idea being that accelerated learning can take place when accompanied by de-suggestion of psychological barriers and positive suggestion.

Suggestopedia includes elements such as:

- the use of relaxing music,
- art
- Additional importance that is given to the **learning environment**
- The **authoritative behaviour of the teacher**

Lozanov noticed that learners have difficulties in acquiring English as the second language because of the fear of the students to get mistakes.

- There is a mental block in the learner's brain (**affective filter**). It blocks so that learners have difficulties to acquire language caused by their fear.

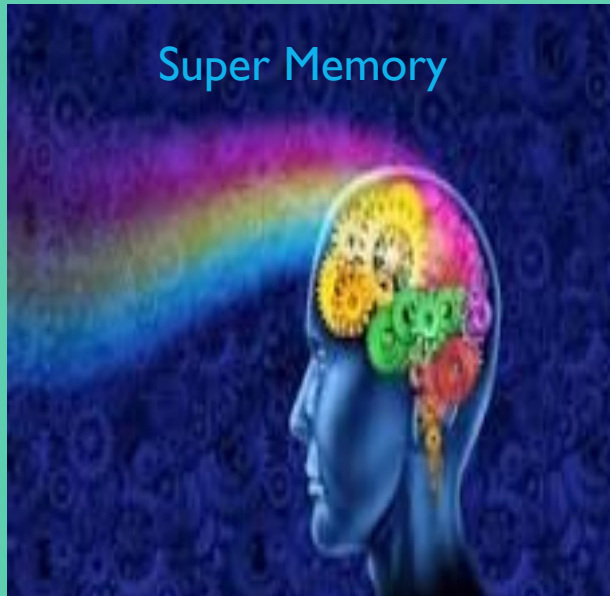

ACCORDING TO LOZANOV

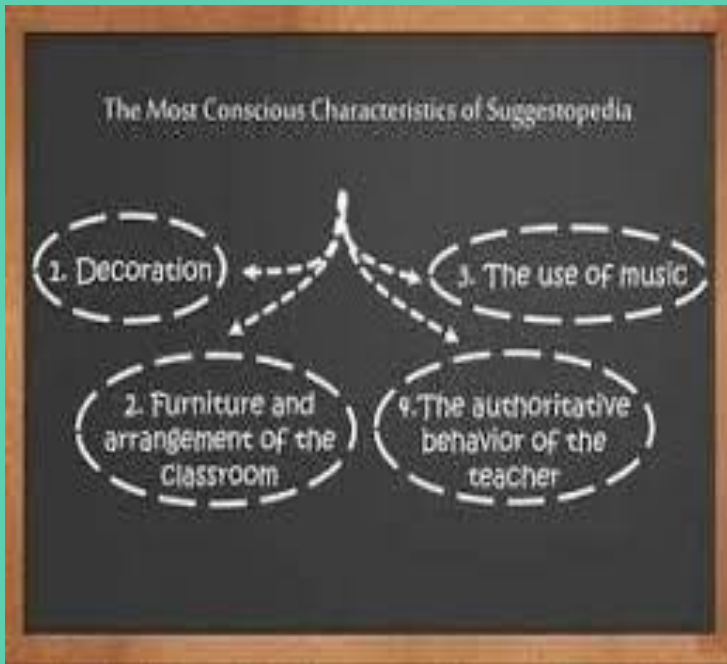
Richards & Rodgers state that **the method itself is supposed to gain authority** by

- ❑ a highly positive attitude

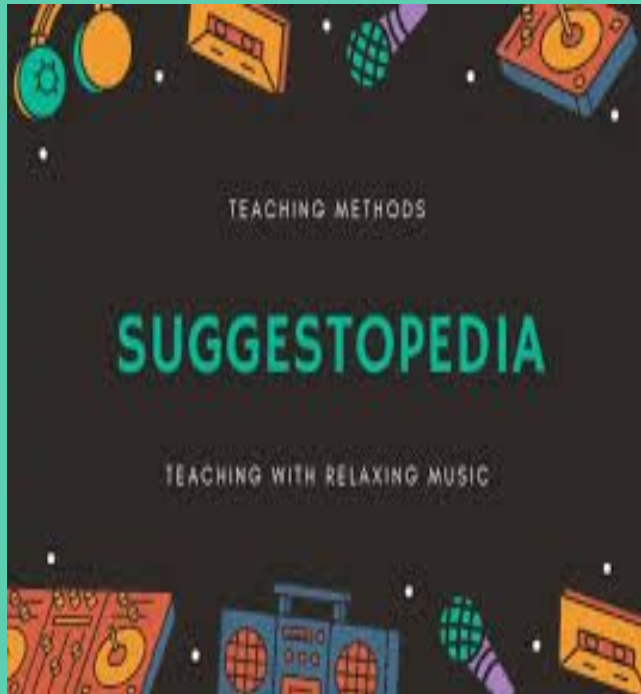

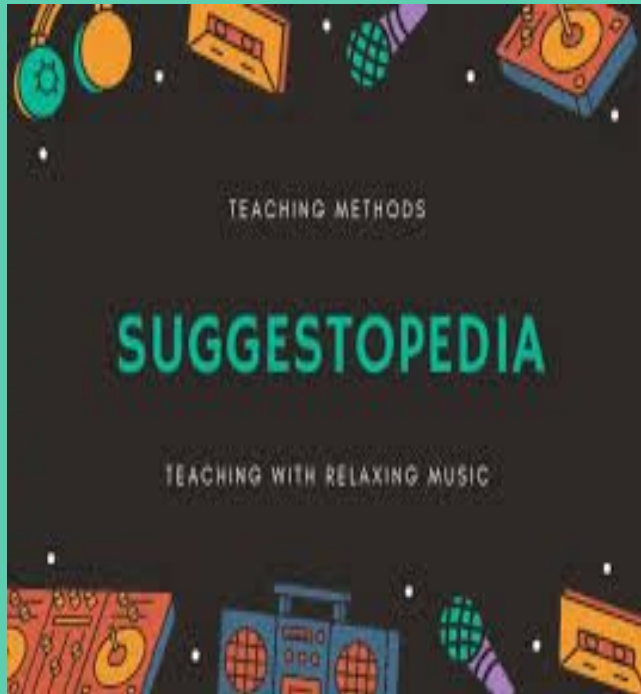

MAIN PRINCIPLES OF SUGGESTOPEDIA



- 1- Learning is facilitated in a **cheerful** environment.
- 2- A student can learn from what is present in the environment, even if his attention is not directed to it (**peripheral learning**).
- 3- If the students trust and respect the teacher's authority, they will accept and retain information better.
- 4- The teacher should recognize that learners bring certain psychological barriers with them to the learning situation. The teacher should attempt to “desuggest” these.
